

Purchasing Tickets

- 1-Ride Tickets may be purchased at a Ticket Vending Machine (TVM) located on each rail station platform. TVM's only accept \$5 and \$20 bills and do not give change. Only the Donelson Station TVM accepts \$1 and \$10 bills.
- Pre-Purchased 1-Ride Tickets, 10-Ride Tickets and Monthly Passes are available inside Riverfront Station. Operating Hours are 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 6 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. on Friday, and 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.
- Pre-Purchased tickets and passes also are available at Mt. Juliet City Hall, Lebanon City Hall, select Kroger stores and Music City Central.
- Only Pre-Purchased 10-Ride Tickets and Monthly Passes are available on the Web site at www.MusicCityStar.org.

Tickets are not sold onboard the Music City Star. If you board the train without a ticket, your fare will be \$75.

Getting Started

It is easy to enjoy the convenience of the Music City Star Commuter Rail Service. The information you need is in this Ride Guide. Continue reading to learn about the rail stations, buying tickets, procedures and more.

East Corridor Route Map

The rail stations and their addresses are listed below. Each station, except for Riverfront, has a Park & Ride facility for Music City Star passengers to use free of charge.

- Lebanon Station – 334 W. Baddour Parkway
- Martha Station – State Route 109 and Powell Grove Road
- Mt. Juliet Station – 22 East Division Street
- Hermitage Station – 4121 Andrew Jackson Parkway
- Donelson Station – 2705 Lebanon Pike
- Riverfront Station – 108 1st Avenue South, Nashville



How to Ride

- Purchase your 1-Ride Ticket, 10-Ride Ticket or Monthly Pass before boarding the train. Please see the purchasing tickets section for details.
- Stand behind the yellow and blue safety lines on the platform to wait for the train.
- Give your ticket to the conductor to be validated as you are boarding.
- Listen for your stop from the announcement of the conductor before the train approaches each station.

Special Needs

All trains and stations are fully accessible for people with disabilities. For boarding assistance, please wait on the ramp. If you are hearing impaired, tell the conductor where you want to exit.

Bicycles

Bicycles may be stored in the wheelchair sections of each car, provided the areas are unused. Passengers must supply their own Bungee cords to secure them.

Holiday Schedule

The Music City Star operates every scheduled weekday, regardless of weather conditions. The train does not operate on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Connecting Bus Service

MTA buses meet each train upon arrival at Riverfront Station. Please go online to www.MusicCityStar.org for maps.

- There is no additional cost to take these shuttles.
- Route 93 travels up Broadway, West End and over to the Vanderbilt University and Belmont University campuses.
- Route 94 loops through downtown.
- Commuters who do not work along either of these routes should take Route 94 to Music City Central to catch a bus to their final destination.
- Commuters whose work location is not served by the shuttle buses may qualify for a proximity card at no extra charge to complete their trip. Please call Customer Care at (615) 862-5950 to inquire.

Emergency Ride Home Program

RTA offers an Emergency Ride Home program that provides six rides home annually to registered, regular commuters in case of an emergency. To register for the Emergency Ride Home program, go to www.RTArelaxandride.com or call Customer Care at (615) 862-5950.

General Information

- Ticket must be purchased before boarding.
- Packages and luggage are subject to search at any time.
- Weapons are not allowed on the train at any time.
- Smoking and use of tobacco products are prohibited.
- Drinks should be in closed containers.
- Service animals are allowed on board.
- Disruptive or threatening behavior should be reported immediately to the conductor.

Courtesy Rules

- Use headphones with radios, iPods, CD and MP3 players.
- Use cell phone etiquette and avoid loud conversations when using your phone.
- Use only one seat per passenger and keep feet off of the other seats.
- Put trash in waste receptacles.
