Special New Year's Eve train tickets *SOLD OUT* *All 650 free rides provided by Miller Lite claimed*

NASHVILLE – The Regional Transportation Authority of Middle Tennessee (RTA) and Miller Lite's special excursion train to the Music City's New Year's Eve Bash on Broadway is a sellout. All 650 tickets available to the general public have been claimed.

Customers who reserved seats will receive one round-trip ticket for the New Year's Eve train and must show the ticket to train personnel for scanning when boarding on both trips. Customers also must present their ticket to security personnel to enter the checkpoint area at Riverfront Station. **Weekday Music City Star tickets and passes are not accepted on the New Year's Eve train.**

The New Year's Eve excursion train is scheduled to depart Lebanon Station (334 W. Baddour Parkway) at 6:40 p.m., Martha (65 Martha Circle) at 6:51 p.m., Mt. Juliet (22 E. Division St.) at 7 p.m., Hermitage (4121 Andrew Jackson Parkway) at 7:08 p.m., Donelson (2705 Lebanon Pike) at 7:15 p.m. and arrive at Riverfront Station at 7:30 p.m. The return train will leave Riverfront Station 45 minutes after the fireworks show ends and will stop at all the stations. Parking is free at the outlying stations and is not available at Riverfront Station.

Backpacks will be allowed onboard the train. Any items that will not fit underneath the seat, such as large coolers, bikes and wagons, are not permitted on the train. All personal items are subject to search. See the [Bash on Broadway House Rules](#) for additional information.
